

The Peleng 8mm Lens

Congratulations on your purchase of one of the finest optical products ever produced! ☺ The Peleng 8mm lens from the Belomo optical factory in Belarus is made from the purest optical glass and features the most advanced vacuum deposited antireflection coating.

Resulting images are crisp and sharp, with no color distortion.

Changing the Lens Mount

The Peleng 8mm lens has a Pentax-screw mount. To change to the Nikon mount, unscrew the three set-screws (*carefully* and over a light-colored surface) holding on the rear mount.

Note that on certain Nikon-mount cameras, there might not be enough clearance to use the behind-the-lens filters.



Using Filters

Your Peleng lens has an assortment of behind-the-lens filters. Screw the desired filter on, behind the lens.

Using the Lenses

The Peleng 8mm lens feature a unique aperture mechanism to allow you to frame your subject with the lens fully open, and then quickly close it down to the desired aperture for filming.

The manual aperture ring is labeled “lock / unlock”.

When changing aperture, turn the manual aperture ring all the way in the “unlock” direction. Set the desired aperture. Then you can turn the manual aperture ring back in the lock direction to close down the lens to the set aperture.

While it is possible to *decrease* the aperture without first turning the manual aperture ring in the “unlock” direction, **do not do this** when opening up the aperture! The manual aperture ring will function as a lock preventing this.
